Anticipating three consecutive Fridays at Afton Alps in Jan or Feb with bus transport from GH for interested students and parents. Flyer will be sent home with information prior to winter break. Fees in \$25-\$45 range per student per trip depending on need for lessons, skis and final transportation costs.</p> <p>Cultural event committee is meeting. Plan to have a "dress up" day for each continent (except Antarctica) with food/dance/art activities available at the event itself which will be held Jan 29. Sign up for volunteers is almost ready.</p> <p>Spelling bee- a request for parents interested in forming a committee will be in the next newsletter.</p> <p>Family fun night- over 100 families completed surveys with interest in bowling and roller skating. Bowling will be planned for after carnival-possibly towards end of the school year. Roller skating will be held after 5th grade patrol skating event-likely in February and will be on a Thursday night. We will have the entire facility reserved for us in both cases.</p> <p>Label contest set to kick off in January. They will repair if you have instruments in your attic! Great conference attendance (97% of families attended). Cyberbullying workshop in being planned to educate parents. School staff are analyzing student test data to focus on continued growth. Target areas have been identified. Magnet survey results are available at https://www.surveymonkey.com/results/SM-88GZC2CV/: Staff are researching best practices in magnet schools. Kindergarten for next year- 54 attendance area students, will accept approximately 50 students in lottery. Current families must submit lottery applications for incoming siblings by January 14th!</p>
