We're showing a \$13,000 deficit for the year, but this is because we've paid the school for our budget and still have fundraisers to go to raise the remainder.</p> <p>Jenny reported that 7 children attended the Boltz camp to raise \$140 profit for school. She will advertise a similar opportunity for President's Day.</p> <p>Ski club is moving ahead with 35-40 students signed up for each event. They will bring one bus and should have enough chaperones.</p> <p>Cultural event was a big success with approximately 450 in attendance. Booster Club approved \$20 thank you for district American Indian advocates who were present and have gone above and beyond to support our school with additional art projects for some of our classes.</p>

Dana is working to coordinate additional art projects related to American Indians for some classes. Skateville family night is coming up February 26th.</p> <p>Parent leader report shared with group.</p> <p>Husky Hustle still in need of leadership for its committee. Janelle and Dana continue to work on it- group of parents from last year is experienced and could run it without leader if needed.</p> <p>Carnival planning is in full swing- currently working on securing game sponsors and big ticket items for silent auction/basket raffle.</p> <p>Square 1 asking if we plan to do it again. Plans to do in September next year with items to arrive in early December to allow time to ship for holidays.</p> <p>No school supply, Scrip or Pizza Man updates at this time.</p> <p>Amazon.com referral program has raised \$453.46 so far.</p> <p>Emma Holmblad mentioned a site that sells organic, natural and overall healthy products for kids and families. They give us 15% of your purchase. We need to raise \$100 to get paid (amount accrues until we reach \$100). Check out www.mightynest.com !</p>

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<p>Principal's Report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Facilities update PowerPoint 	<p>Scott</p>	<p>Scott shared that kindergarten lottery has been held. 100 kindergarteners are expected next fall with 40 from attendance area and 60 from magnet lottery. 79 kindergarteners on waiting list. We will have 5 sections in grades K-4 next year. We will also have a pre-kindergarten program that will be held at Woodland Elementary as we don't have space. Program will target students from low income and English Learner families as well as students in early childhood special education. Plan to house at Glacier Hills in the future if space is added onto the building. Echo Park and Oak Ridge will become magnet schools in the near future and this may mean sharing some resources from GH with these additional magnet schools.</p> <p>Scott shared the district Powerpoint on the Facilities bond referendum proposal. The following is currently proposed for GH: an addition with 4 classrooms and dedicated space for arts and science. Our front entrance would be re-configured to route visitors through the office during the school day and we would receive digital security cameras, updated door locks, and a panic button for office to contact emergency personnel. Money would also fund technology including 1-to-1 electronic device initiative for grades 4-12 and 3-to-1 devices for K-3. Finally, our driveway would be straightened to ease traffic flow and sidewalk re-routed for safer crossing at beginning and end of school day. District is gathering feedback on proposal and final proposal has yet to be presented to the school board.</p>
