New Business

Oct. 5th. Referendum Information sharing: night event on referendum. Scott and Kevin Samsel will present on informational referendum topics for parents. Invite families to attend. GH needs an addition to the building. Team suggested having a few computers set up for families to check their voting location.

Updates

Volunteer Coordinators Report: See volunteers needed for this year & Husky Hustle

Parent Leader Update: Ambuja is our parent rep and she has not had a meeting yet, first meeting is tomorrow 9/15.

Husky Hustle Update: Janelle & Kari, packets went out last Friday in folders to youngers/ only child. Goal is to raise \$30,000 resulting in a school bonfire party at GH on Friday, Oct. 9th (about a week after the HH race). GH staff will get a staff code so they can participate in the event free. Jenica will be emailing Husky Hustle participants a thank-you for those paying through pay pal. Students from School of Environmental Science may be able to help volunteer for this event. The Boy Scouts will staff the on route water stations. A team has been working on the Husky Hustle this year. A new chairperson needs to take over for next year (Janelle & Dana have helped this year, but need to do their main volunteer coordinator roles next year).

Carnival Update: Date is April 15th. 2016

School Supply Update: Ambuja, GH almost \$437 made. Some parents did not receive their child's school supply boxes due to mix up. Team also discussed whether the school supply option should be continued for next year. An idea for parents who order the school supplies is to have them pick up their child's box during assessments next August 2016 versus the boxes being delivered to classrooms. This will ensure that the child has received their school supplies. Sharpies would be available at that time for families to label their supplies. Ambuja needs a person to step up to be the school supply coordinator by this spring so she can train her/ him in. Ambuja has this year and next with us before her daughter attends middle school.

Square 1 Art Update: Jenica, Christina, & Alissa are working on this. Team discussed placing examples of the Square 1 Art in the hallway showcases. Information will be sent in Friday folders on 9/25 with orders due on 10/12. Third grade, Mrs. Mujica, and a few other classes incorporated Square 1 Art into their curriculum last year.
